Eligibility & Details:

- Current high school sophomores, juniors or seniors
- Four students serve per year
- One-year term with optional summer participation

Duties:

- Attend monthly City Council meetings
- Host monthly Junior Council committee meeting and provide report at each monthly Council meeting
- Propose, develop, and lead one to two projects per school year that are focused on resolving issues facing youth in our community
- Attend community and City-related events
- Shadow City officials and tour departments
